You may also obtain a referral from the county bar association. Another resource is the consumer protection department in your state's Attorney General's office.

If you have a home ownership or foreclosure issue and cannot find a lawyer to review your case, you may want to try contacting a [housing counselor listed on this website www.hud.gov/foreclosure](#).

Your legal claim will be lost if you wait too long to seek legal help. If you are sued, almost always you must quickly file a written answer explaining why you dispute the claim or you will automatically lose the case.
